## COOKIE NOTICE

### 1. INTRODUCTION

At Ultraviolette (hereinafter referred to as “Ultraviolette”, “us”, “we”, and “our”), we value your privacy, and we commit to staying transparent in using your data. This Cookie Notice explains how we use cookies and similar technologies to recognise you when you visit our website at <https://www.ultraviolette.com> ("website"). When you make your first visit to our website, you will have the option to grant, decline or customize consent for the collection and use of cookies. You can also modify your preferences anytime using the Cookie Settings option located on the website footer.

#### 1.1 WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (Computer, Tablet, Smartphone, etc.) when you visit a website. They enable websites to recognise your device and store information about your preferences or past actions to enhance your browsing experience.

#### 1.2 USAGE OF COOKIES AND THEIR PURPOSE

Our website uses cookies for the following purposes:

- Manage and present the information displayed on our website
- Assist you in navigating pages,
- Analyse your use of our website, and
- Help us understand your preferences.

Generally, our cookies perform three different functions:

- Enabling our websites to function properly: Some cookies are essential for the operation of our websites. For example, in sign-in and authentication, we use cookies to ensure that you are shown the correct web pages for your location or to identify when we have broken links or other technical issues with the website;
- For analyzing visitor behavior, we may use cookies to analyze how our visitors use our websites and to monitor website performance. This allows us to provide an experience by making sure that our content and layout remain relevant to you. For example, we use cookies to keep track of which pages and links are most popular and which do not provide the information that’s required by our visitors.

- Optimizing and personalizing Cookies are also used to optimize the web pages that you visit and to personalize the content that we show you across all our digital assets based on what we understand about your requirements.

## 2. TYPES OF COOKIES DEPLOYED ON OUR WEBSITE

### A. First-Party Cookies and Third-Party Cookies

**First-party Cookies** are created and managed by Ultraviolette Automotive, allowing us to remember your preferences, login details, and other session information directly related to your interactions on our website.

**Third-party Cookies** are set by trusted service providers to track and analyse your interactions with our website. These cookies, placed by services like advertising networks, social media platforms, or analytics providers, track your online activities across different websites to build a profile of your interests for advertising, analytics, and other purposes. Some of our pages display content from external providers.

### B. Categories Of Cookies

#### a. Strictly Necessary Cookies – Always Active

Necessary cookies are essential for the website to function properly and ensure a seamless user experience. These cookies are typically set in response to user actions, such as setting privacy preferences, logging in, or filling out forms, which enable requests for services. They also include session cookies that track movement across pages, allowing users to navigate efficiently without re-authentication. While you can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, some parts of the website may not function correctly. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information, and your consent is not required for their use.
